The admissions process has two components: (1) the completion and submission of this application form and (2) confirmation of the applicant's character by five academic teachers. The confirmation of character process is outlined in the notification email all eligible students receive. **Applications are due—submitted to the appropriate box in E117—by the end of the school day on Friday, March 14, 2025.** No late applications will be accepted.

To qualify, a student must have a minimum of 10 extracurricular points. Points are earned by participating in a DHS-sponsored extracurricular activity (activities that qualify are listed below). The charts list each qualified extra-curricular and the number of points which can be earned each season or year. In addition, a student serving as an officer or captain of an extra-curricular activity will earn one extra point per season or year. Participation in an activity or class in which a student receives a grade does not count for extracurricular points.

Students may also earn a maximum of 3 points (towards the necessary 10 points) for community service activities/projects. These activities/projects must be on-going during the school year or can be concentrated during a school break. Some examples are: Scouts, Habitat for Humanity, or other volunteer work. Each service activity/project earns 1 point per year. The sponsor for such service work must submit a verification letter (sent via email to mwolf@dist113.org is fine). Verification letters must include the student's name in the body of the letter/email along with a description of the service activity/project, hours spent working on service, and the dates of service. Form letters/emails without a student's name, a description of the work, or dates of service will not be accepted.

2-point activities per year: Animal Rights Club, Anime Club, ARC Tutors, Art Club, Chess Club, Coding for a Cause, Computer Club, DASA, DECA, Deerprints, Delta, DHS Film & TV, DSI, Earthworks, EIU Academic Challenge, Executive Boards, Fashion Club, Feminist Club, Fencing Club, GEM, GIMA, Girls Coding (Code Warriors), Girl Up, Human Rights Club, Israel Club, Jazz Lab Band, Key Club, Marching Band, Mathletes, Medical Careers Club, Model United Nations, Monday/Tuesday Afternoon Jazz, OYAD, Peer Helping, Robotics, Scholastic Bowl, Science Club, Snowball, SOS, Spectrum, Stage Crew, Student Congress (Debate), Student Council, Theatrix, Troubadour, Varsity Club, Warrior Buddies, Warrior Hockey.

1-point athletics per season: Badminton, Baseball, Basketball, Bowling, Cheer Squad, Cross Country, Field Hockey, Football, Golf, Gymnastics, Lacrosse, Soccer, Softball, Swimming/Diving, Tennis, Track & Field (indoor), Track & Field (outdoor), Volleyball, Warrior Dance Team (fall), Warrior Dance Team (winter), Water Polo, Wrestling, Flag Football.
